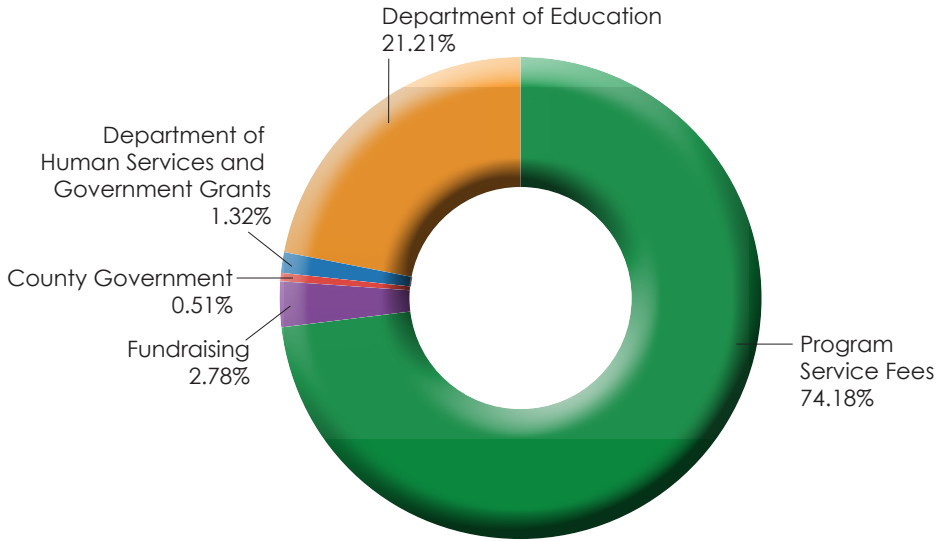

## Income Sources 2020-2021

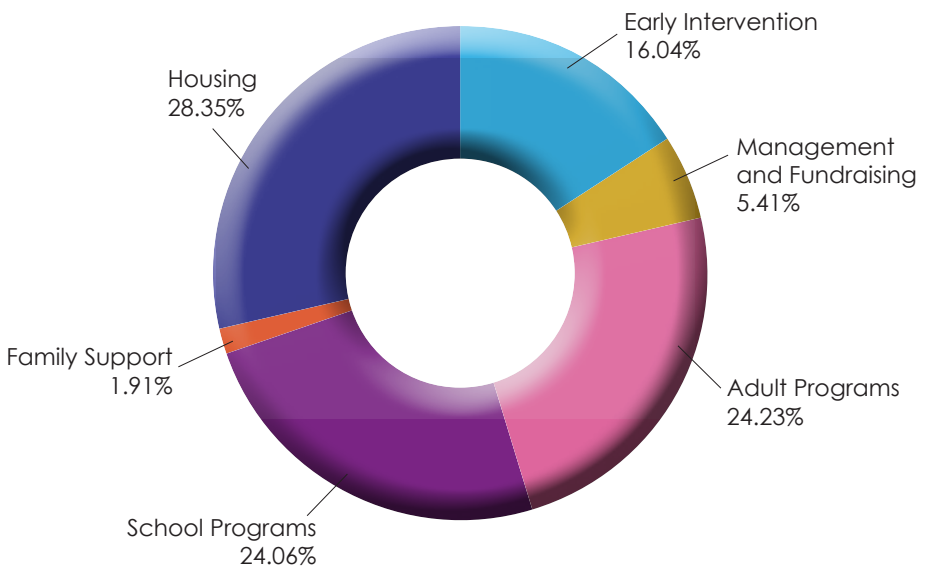
Total Income \$28,693,785
