This past year has been a remarkable one for LADACIN Network! As we reflect on our journey and look ahead, we are proud to share updates on our ongoing efforts and our strong dedication to providing outstanding programs and services.

In March, we proudly kicked off LADACIN's 75th Anniversary at the Rosebud Gala, which achieved a significant marker as the most profitable fundraising event in our history, raising over \$284,000! A heartfelt anniversary video featuring our clients, students, and families donated by a local filmmaker is on our website.

In September 2023, Dr. Nancy Kegelman was elected President of the Board of Trustees. Nancy, the Associate Vice President of Planning and Institutional Effectiveness at Brookdale Community College has served on our Board since 2012 and has helped to develop meaningful partnerships through her strong connection to Brookdale.

Renovations at our Wall Group Home were completed, and we eagerly anticipate welcoming residents in fall 2024. This is our 10th barrier free, fully accessible, supported housing facility for adults with disabilities.

We are proud to announce the renewal of our 22nd accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation for Home Care (CAHC) and all seven Department of Human Services (DHS) licensed facilities received full licensure. We are committed to the highest standards of care for the individuals we serve.

For the 2nd time in three years one of our Schroth School staff received the honor of being designated the ASAH Paraprofessional of the Year- congratulations to Angie Figueroa!

We received a number of generous grants this year including a \$193,000 grant from NJEDA for Give and Take Child Care renovations. These funds will enable us to make significant renovations improving the space and meeting GrowNJ facility requirements.

These accomplishments are due to the collective effort of our dedicated team, our community partners and our generous supporters. Together, we continue building a brighter future for all those we serve.




